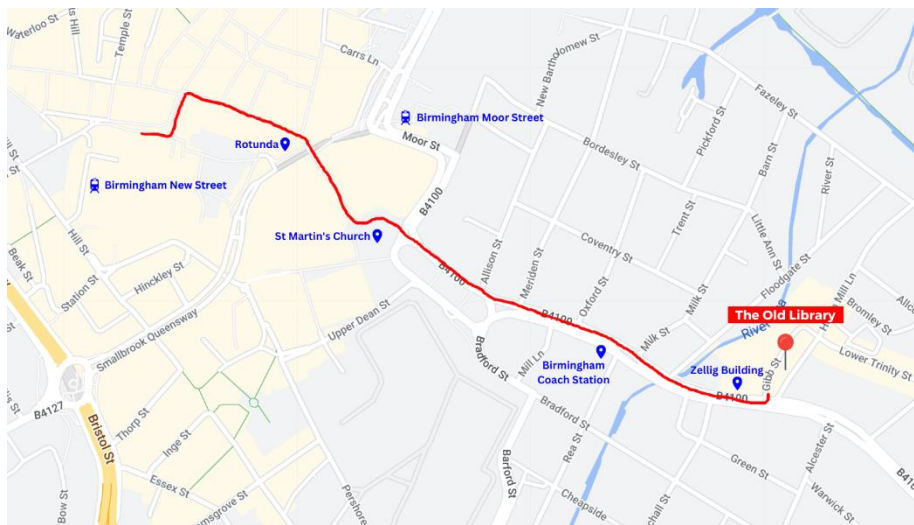


The Old Library

Public Transport Guide

Here is a handy guide of all the public transport options available to get you to The Old Library.

Trains



Birmingham New Street

Direct links to: London Euston, Manchester Piccadilly, Liverpool Lime Street, Cardiff Central, Edinburgh and Glasgow Central.

It is around a 15-minute walk from New Street to The Old Library.

Birmingham Moor Street

Direct links to: London Marylebone, Solihull, and Stratford-upon-Avon.

It is around a 15-minute walk from Moor Street to The Old Library.

Buses

There are plenty of buses that stop on the B4100 (Digbeth High Street) just a 2-minute walk from The Old Library.

Airport

If you are travelling to us via Birmingham Airport, there are plenty of easy ways to complete your journey.

Trains

Direct trains from Birmingham International Train Station (accessed via the monorail) to Birmingham New Street run multiple times an hour.

Bus

Direct buses via the X1 leave Birmingham International Bus Station (accessed via the monorail) roughly every 20 minutes.
